

Geography; In our project 'United' pupils will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas. They will also name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

Throughout the project pupils will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the UK and its counties as well other countries, continents and oceans where relevant.

History; We will be looking at the actions of significant people and organisations who have brought about change with regard to the environment.

PE; We will be developing the physical skills required to take part in Athletics. These will include: throwing, jumping, running, using space well and maintaining balance. Pupils will be organising themselves and their belongings when changing before and after each session.

Computing; We will be using Purple Mash to explore online safety and effective searching.

Maths; This term we will be concentrating on place value, understanding the value of each digit in a two digit number and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Pupils will secure their understanding of number bonds to 10 and begin to explore pairs of numbers that total 20. We will also be reading and writing numbers up to 100 and solving addition and subtraction calculations and problems.

English; This term we will develop handwriting skills by using correct letter formation of both capital and lower case letters and appropriate sizing. We will be looking at narrative writing with a focus on letter writing. We will also be writing labels, captions and posters demonstrating how to use question marks and exclamation marks correctly. When presenting work within small groups the emphasis will be on speaking audibly and fluently with an increasing demand for

RE; We will be asking the question: 'What does it mean to belong to a religion? To answer this question we will look the World Religions of Christianity and Judaism. Our Theme for Harvest this year is 'Love knows no distance'.

PSHE; During our whole school SCIB week we will be looking at substance abuse. In our weekly lesson we will be looking at our Rights and Responsibilities as global citizens and how we impact on the environment. We will also be learning how to manage our feelings, get on with others and feel safe.
