

Nursery Group	Use your phonics mat to look at letter sounds (not letter names)	Please read with your child - see if they can spot any sounds they know in the words.

Miss Prud'homme, Mrs Anker	Use your phonics mat to practice your sounds from set 1 and 2.	Please read with your child for 10 minutes.
Miss Bullard, Miss Turvey, Mrs Ahmed	Use your phonics mat to practice your sounds from set 1 2 and 3.	Please read with your child for 10 minutes.

Prefixes

A prefix is added to a root word to change the meaning of that word.

Examples: I was happy when it rained today. I was **unhappy when it rained today.**

Yesterday I felt very well. Yesterday I felt vey **unwell.**

Can you explain how putting **un in front of happy and fair has changed the meaning of the words?**

- Find five more words that can be changed by adding **un** at the start of the word.**
- Ask an adult to check them and then write them in your book.**

This week we are focusing on the fairy tale 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'.


Tasks for all:

You do not have to do all of them. Choose one that you would like to do. See if you can challenge yourself.

1. Listen to a version of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' on the class page.
1. Can you retell the story to an adult?
1. Act out the story of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' to your family. Can they join in and play one of the characters?
1. Draw a picture of the Troll and the Goats. Can you write a speech bubble to show what they might be saying?

Extra challenge

Have a go at writing a 'role on the wall' for one of the characters. Draw an outline of them. On the inside of your outline write what they look like and on the outside of your outline write how they might be feeling.



Maths Task

Today's focus is **Number and Place Value**.

You do not have to do all the tasks. Choose one that you would like to do. See if you can challenge yourself.



1. Watch a video about ordering one-digit numbers using a number line <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z99d2hv>

Can you order the people in your family by age? Can you find numbers in a paper or magazine, cut them out and create your own number line to 20.

1. Watch a video about ordering two -digit numbers using a number line <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zkkwmp3>

Can you and your family make paper aeroplanes and throw them from a start line. Measure which has gone furthest using a ruler. Can you create your own number line using the distances the planes travelled.

How many different 3 digit numbers can you make with the numbers 4 8 6 2 and 7. How many can you make if you can only have numbers between 600 and 700?
