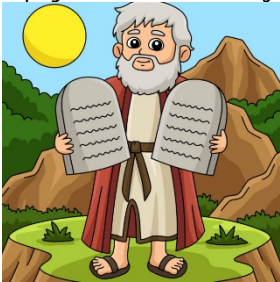
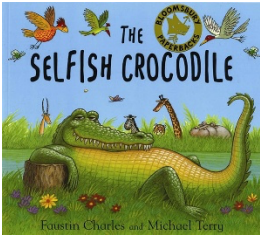


Summer 2 Homework Ideas: Castles, Knights and Dragons – Kingfishers
