








Fledglings Homework Ideas: Ride a Cock Horse

Add pictures or words of the different emotions you might feel in each zone. 
<p>Research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out about the Cattle Market that used to be in Banbury. • Find out about Banbury Castle. <p>Present your information in any way you want (writing, drawing, verbally, construction)</p> 	<p>Nursery Rhymes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select a nursery rhyme and add some musical accompaniment to it with either instruments or body percussion. • Can you keep a steady beat? 	<p>Routes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a map of your route to school • What do you go past on your way to school? Can you label these on your map? 	<p>All about me</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture of yourself and think about some of the things you like. You might like to draw a picture of things you like around you or ask an adult at home to help you write them.
