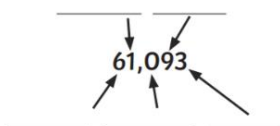

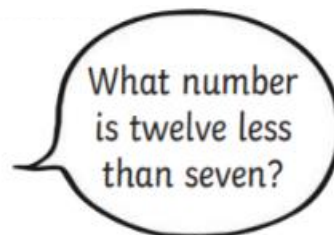
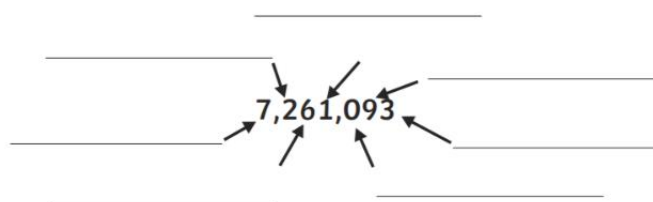
Write the value of the underlined digit in each number:
